- Current pro shop hours are 9 am to 5 pm, Monday thru Friday. Evening and weekend appointments are made for any potential banquet and golf outing planners. The course is looking to get the green aerified in the coming weeks and then getting the course open to the public as soon as weather permits.
- All Tee and Water sponsorships have been filled for the 2019 season.
- The CHGC staff is reviewing applications for our open seasonal positions. Interviews to occur in the first week of March with seasonal employment starting in April.
- CHGC was represented at the Cleveland Golf Show February 15 – 17 and the Pittsburgh Golf Show February 22 -24.
- The current golf staff and PGA Professionals will be attending rules workshops on the 2019 Rules of Golf. The workshops will be conducted by the WPGA and will review the 31 primary changes to rules of golf.
- CHGC participated in a focus group on the new World Handicap system that will be launched in 2020. The focus group allowed CHGC to offer their views on the proposed World Handicap system from a course and player perspective. The information from the focus group will be sent to the USGA and R&A.
- The CHGC Clubhouse sustained shingle damage from the high winds on February 24 & 25. A roofing contractor was called in to repair the sections of the roof that lost shingles.
