Waterpark	Painting around the pool is underway. Spray pad, pool border, shower rooms are complete. Slide structure to begin weather permitting.
Park Fire Station	Conducted a meeting with JCI, RSSC, IES and Allen and Sheriff to discuss the corrective measures on the HVAC system. Pricing has been requested for the addition of electric re-heats on the old areas of the station to correct the excessive humidity issues experienced over the summer months.
ВСТР	Waiting for driveway to be paved to cut safety and exit loops into the gate access. Gate will be put on the access control system immediately following.
Ambulance Bldg.	Fall PM is underway.
Highlands Golf Course	 Plumber was brought in to jet the underground sanitary sewer lines with high temperature pressurized water to remove excessive buildup of grease. Grinder pumps were removed, and tank was vacuumed during jetting to avoid grease into the pumps and discharge line. Lines were videoed after jetting and low spots as well as inverted fitting were discovered on the piping. Discussions on corrective actions is underway with engineering. Waterproofing Co. is scheduled for 10/29 to seal leak into the cart storage from a conduit penetration and along the front, under the entrance doors to the clubhouse. Turfgrass maintenance will handle all digging to expose conduit.
Municipal Bldg.	Working with PM to coordinate shutdowns and tie ins for the Maker Space project. Working on new office space for Communication employee to start first week in November.
Preventative Maint.	Fall PM is beginning to prepare all heating equipment for the cold weather. Municipal bldg., PW, Treatment Plant with the fire facilities to follow.
