New Castle District

- In reaction to the publisher embargos on sale of eBooks and downloadable titles to libraries, NCDL libraries have agreed to a 6 month boycott on eBooks & downloadable audio titles from Blackstone, Simon & Schuster, and Macmillan; this follows the lead of several large library systems throughout PA and the country
