Fairway Facts

- Clubhouse and parking lot was weeded the week of 5-4.
- Putting green area was prepared and seeded the week of 5-4.
- Number 11 greenside bunker and the waste bunker on hole 16 was prepared and hydro-seeded the week of 5-18.
- Hole 10 right-side fairway bunkers had drainage fixed the week of 5-11.
- Hole 11 bunker drainage was completed the week of 4-27.
- Toilets and wash stations were moved onto the course (holes 3 and 14) the week of 4-27.
- Tees are being mowed on a weekly schedule.
- Fairways are on a weekly mowing schedule.
- Greens are on every other day mowing schedule.
- Greens are now at the height for the summer.
- Rough mowing is being done weekly.
- Bunkers are being raked 2-3 times weekly.
- Tee divot repairs started the week of 5-18.
- Irrigation repairs have been made on holes 1, 11, 16 the week of 5-18.
- Equipment repairs are being done as needed.
- Pavilion was cleaned up the week of 5-11.
- Tee stones have been trimmed the week of 5-18.
- Tee, green and fairway sprinklers were trimmed the week of 5-11.
