Park staff checks the restrooms daily to make sure they are operational, and the heat is on. Trails in the parks are cleaned within 48 hours of a winter storm ending. Projects in the parks are in the planning stages and will begin when the weather breaks in the spring. Sports associations have given us their plans for opening this spring. Grounds staff will assist
