- We are still in process of hiring the seasonal staff for 2021.
- Course posting has been completed.
- Bunker drainage was done on holes 14 and 17 the week of 3-1.
- Greens where mow and rolled the week of 3-1.
- Approaches where mow the week of 3-1.
- Greens where sprayed the week of 3-1 to clean up any snow mold and we applied a seed head control.
- Fairways where mowed the week of 3-8.
- Aeration and topdressing of the greens were done the week of 3-8.
- Green topdressing was drug for the final time the week of 3-15.
- Fairways where solid tinned the week of 3-8.
- All sticks were picked up throughout the course the week 3-8.
- Tees have been verti-cut the week of 3-8.
- Tee markers where refurbished and finished the week of 3-15.
- All sprinklers have been trimmed the week of 3-15.
- Tee stones where trimmed the week of 3-15.
- New bunker sand was placed in holes 16,14,12, 13 and 10.
- All golf course stakes, signs, trash cans and markers were put out the week of 3-15.
- The pumphouse irrigation system was inspected the week of 3-15 and everything checked out good for this season.
- Irrigation repairs were made to the entrance sign area and the small putting green. We will continue to make repairs as they become visible.
