5. Cranberry Township EMS Annual Update to the Board

The Leadership of the Cranberry Township EMS (CTEMS) will present their annual report to the Board of Supervisors this evening.

Chief Ted Fessides provided an annual update of the Cranberry Township Emergency Medical Service (CTEMS). Chief Fessides thanked the community for the tremendous amount of support provided during the pandemic in 2020. CTEMS continued with community service throughout the year. They transitioned to virtual training sessions and several members furthered their education. They continued to provide such services as car seat installations, CPR training and performing Safe Landings with COVID restrictions. During 2020, CTEMS accomplished the following:

- Joined the AMR/FEMA Strike Team
- Partnered with UPMC Senior Living to COVID Test their staff and residents
- Partnered with University of Pittsburgh Scope program to address addiction and mental health
- Won PA EMS Agency of the Year 2020
- Changed EMS billing company

The above mentioned were all accomplished while dealing with decreased revenues due to the pandemic. Decreased revenues led to a wage freeze across the board for 2021, reduction in outreach to part-time, the removal of a unit from response service and a delay in capital purchasing.

There was a 15% drop in call volume from 2019 to 2020. As a result, the revenue also decreased in 2020 by \$22,756 per month.

The pandemic has accelerated the financial issues of CTEMS. A PPP loan and grants carried them through, but a fair and equitable agreement will be needed for continued service.

The Board commended CTEMS on their many achievements and thanked them for their service to the community. The Board conveyed the desire to work together to find solutions to move forward.
