Fairway Facts

- Clubhouse snow fence was removed the week of 4-5.
- Clubhouse weeding, edging, and applying of a weed pre-emergence was done the week of 4-5.
- Clubhouse parking lot was weeded, trees trimmed, and a pre-emergence weed control was done the week of 4-5.
- Tees were aerated and top-dressed the week of 3-22.
- Tee stones and sprinklers were trimmed the week of 4-19.
- Fairway sprinklers were trimmed the week of 4-19.
- Bunkers have been cleaned out the week of 3-29 and are being raked on a normal program.
- Reshaped greenside bunkers on holes 12, 16 have been graded and seeded. They will be ground under repair until established.
- Greens have been amended and fertilized the week of 4-12.
- Fairways have been fertilized the week of 4-12.
- Rough has been fertilized the week of 4-19.
- Irrigation system is up and operating with minor repairs.
- Irrigation repairs have been made on holes 2, 3, 7, 12, 14.
- Toilets have been placed on the course the week of 3-29.
- Fescue mowing is underway and will be sprayed for weeds.
- We are in the hiring process to fill our long-term seasonal staff.
