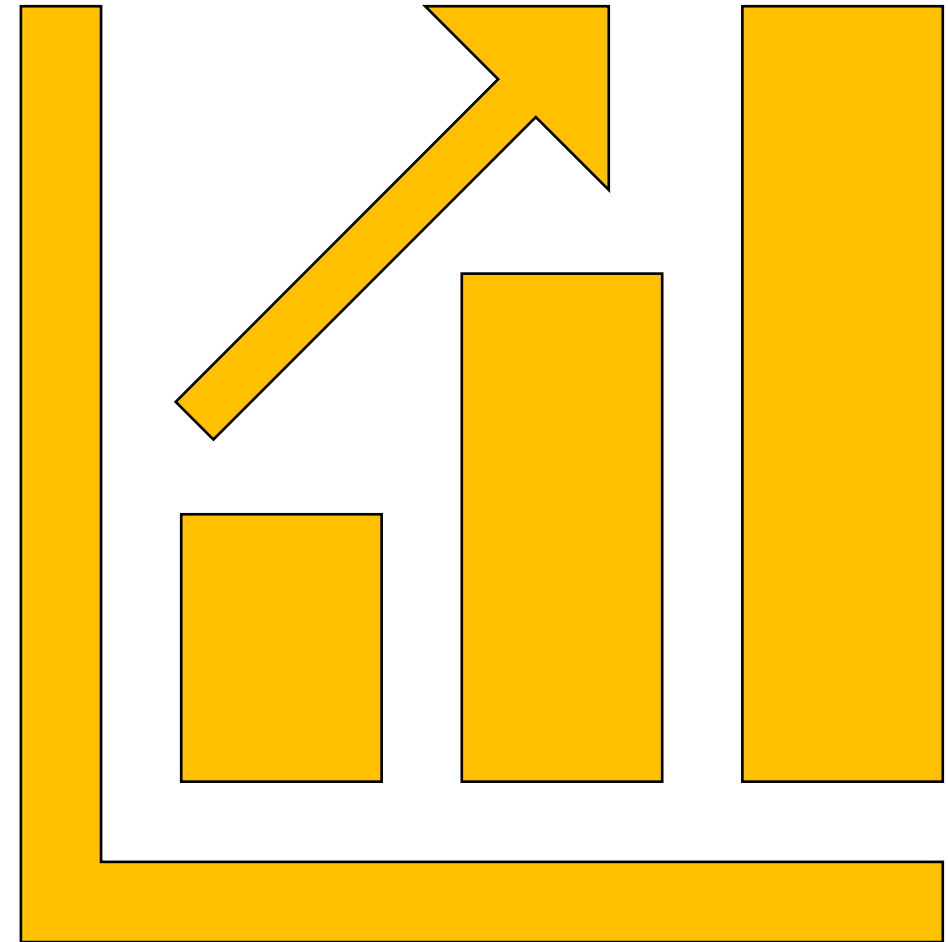

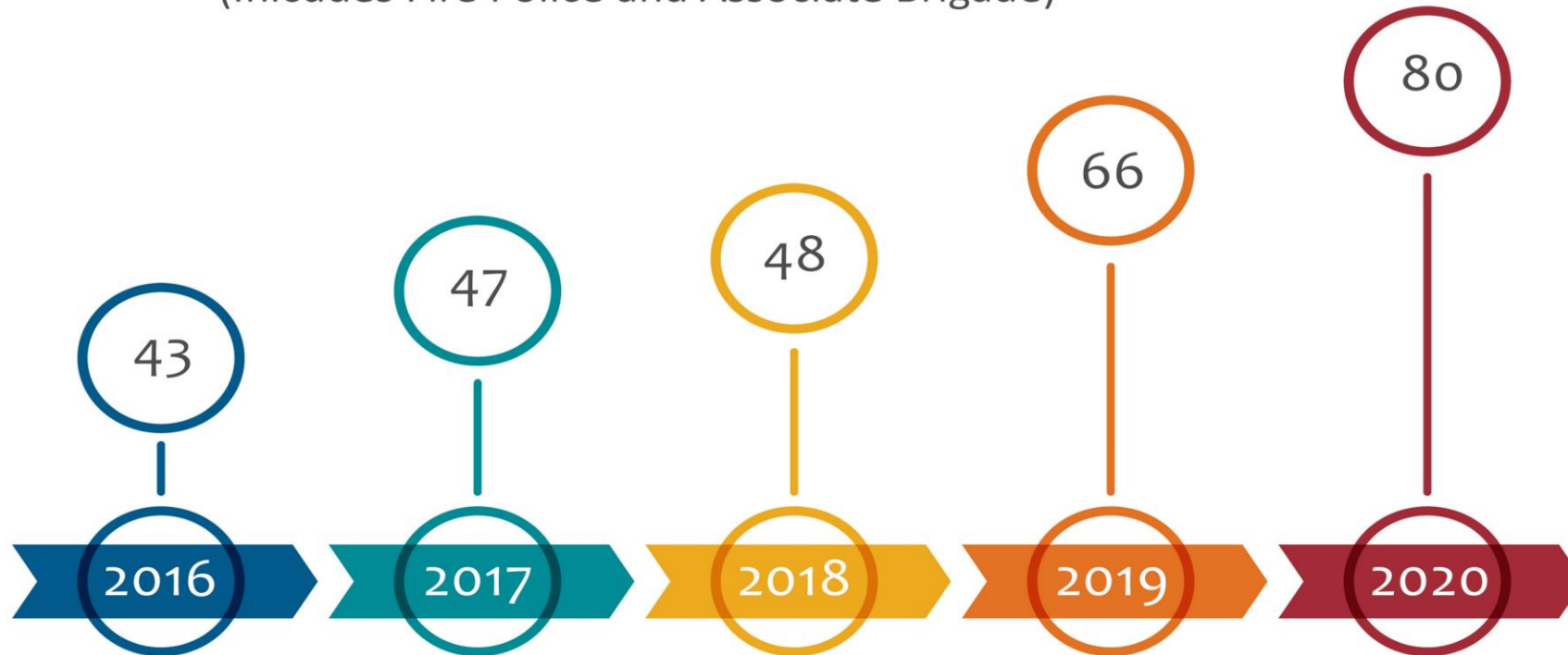

(Includes Fire Police and Associate Brigade)



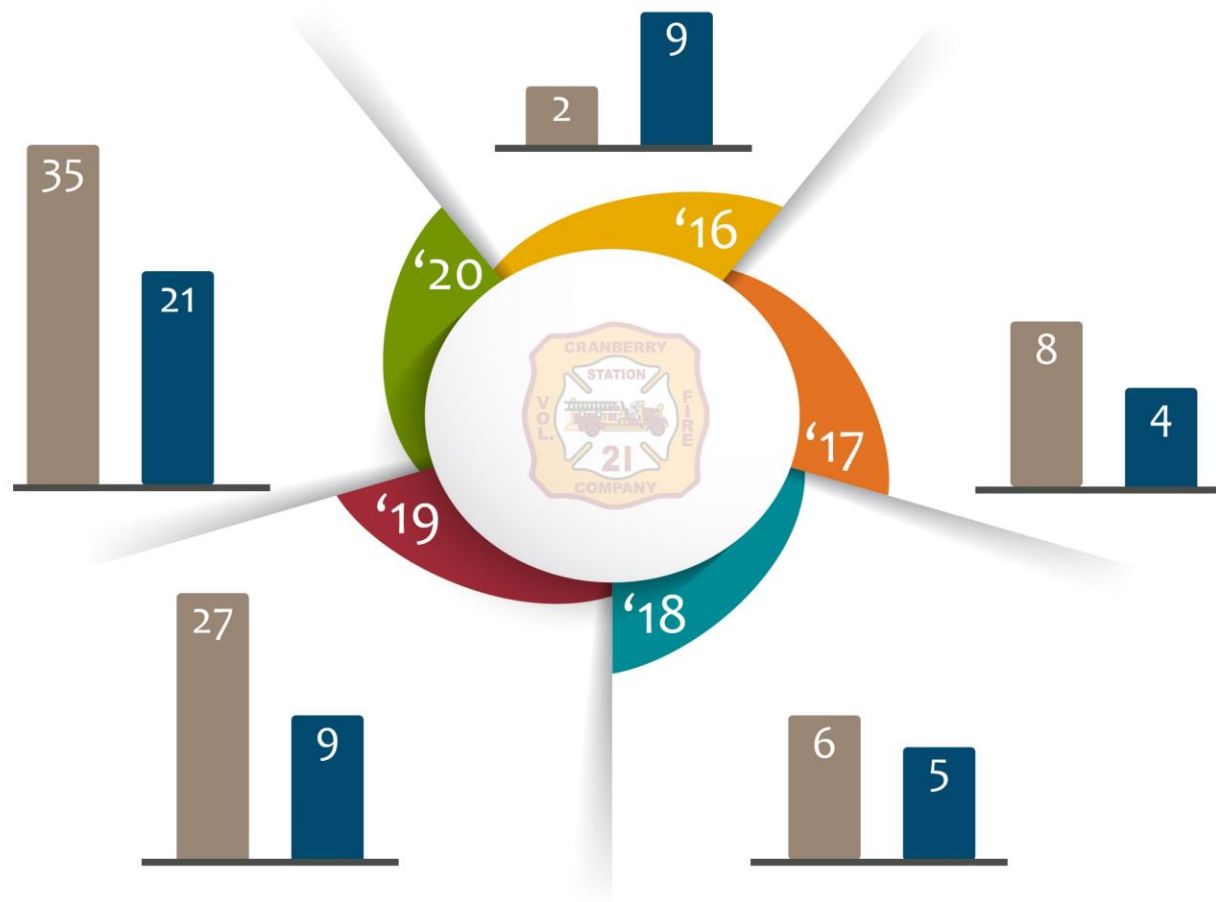

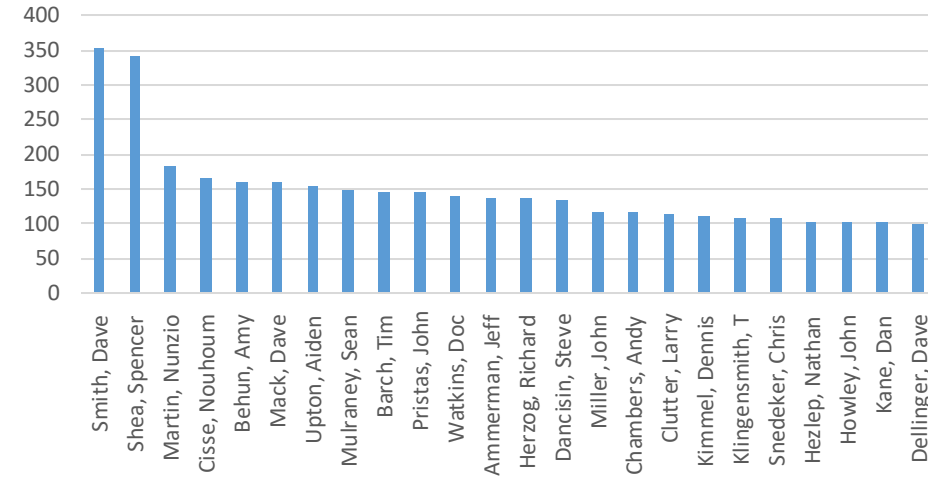

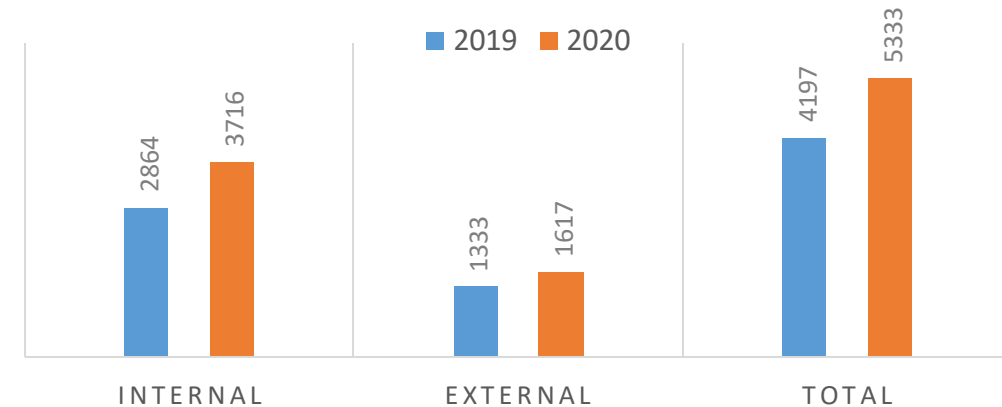

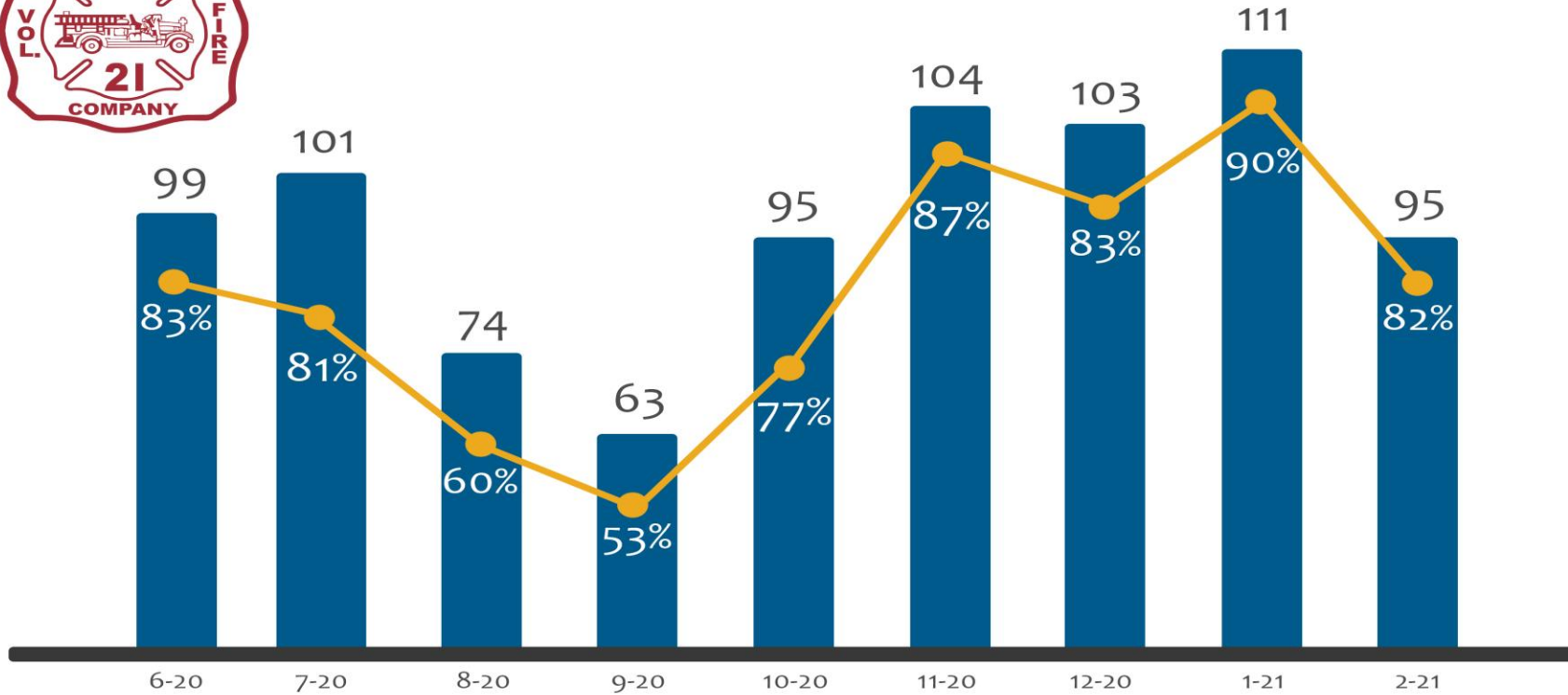

- Percentage of total shifts with 2 or more



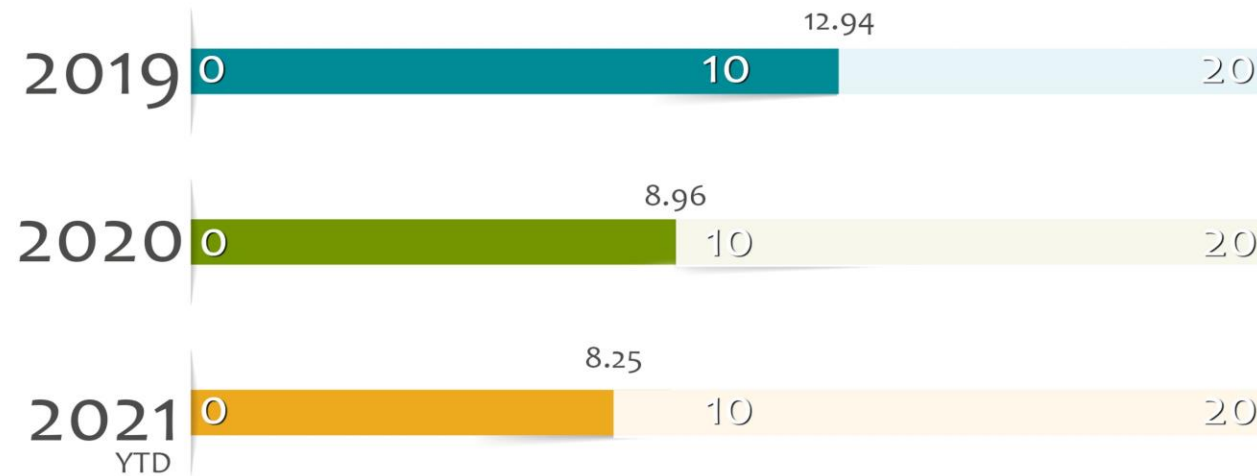

(in minutes)

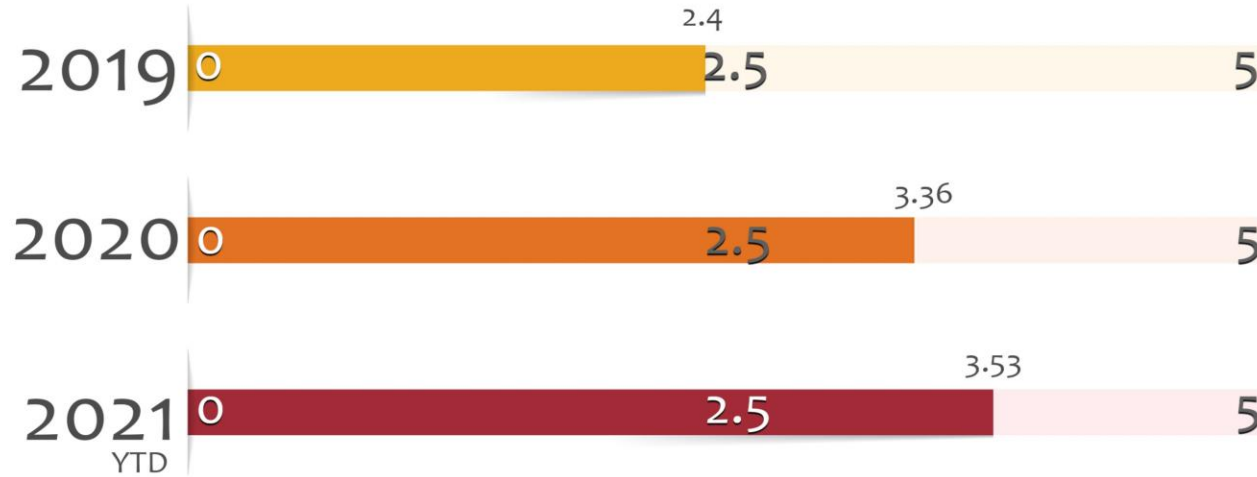

Average Staff per Unit

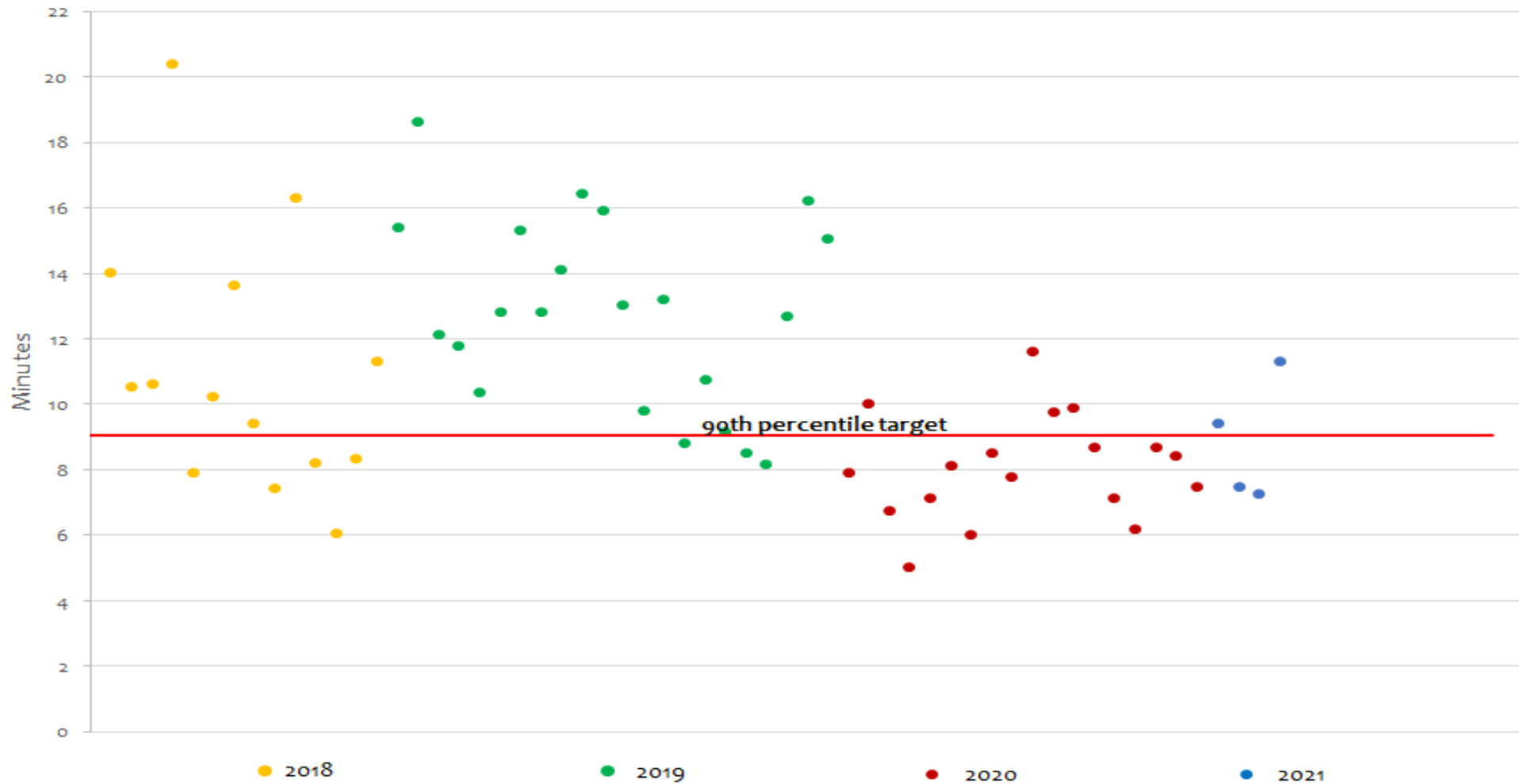

Structure Fire Response Times



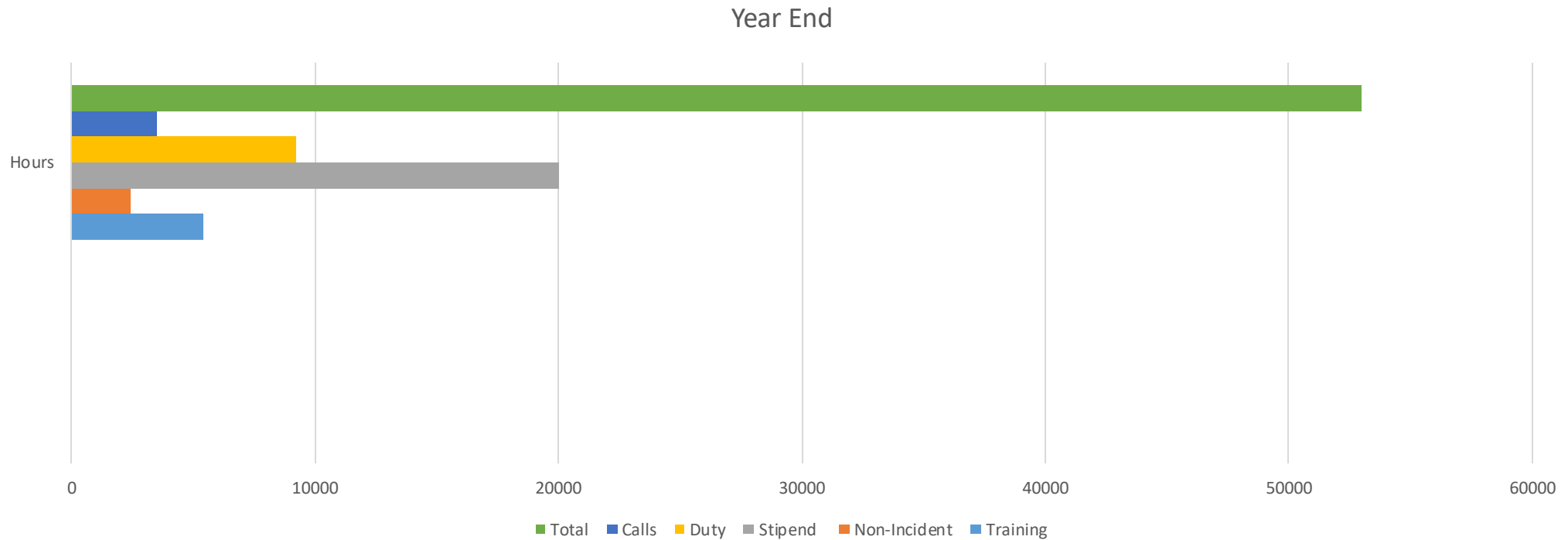

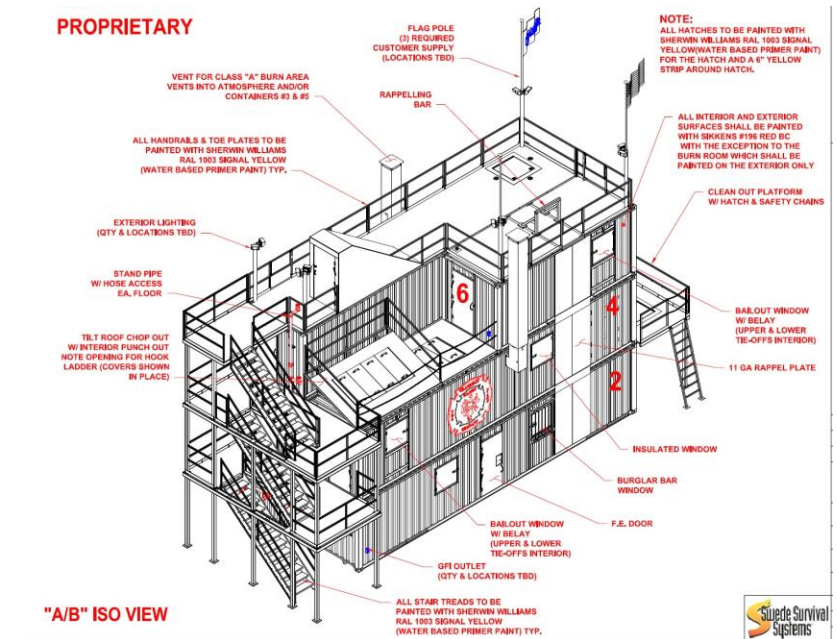
