**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP, A SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP OF THE COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING FORTH CERTAIN GUARANTEES IN RELATION TO AN APPLICATION FOR AN ACTUATED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING SIGNAL ON NORTH BOUNDARY ROAD AT PINEHURST DRIVE.**

WHEREAS, Pedestrian and vehicle safety is of the utmost importance in Cranberry Township.

WHEREAS, Cranberry township is desirous of installing an actuated pedestrian crossing signal on North Boundary Road at Pinehurst Drive to improve pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the actuated pedestrian crossing signal requires a permit and corresponding maintenance agreement by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Cranberry, Butler County, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same, that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of said MUNICIPALITY is authorized and directed to submit the attached Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement, to submit future modifications to the attached Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement, and to submit future Applications for Traffic Signal Approval either in writing or via electronic signature to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to sign this Application on behalf of the MUNICIPALITY.
