FACILITIES	
Waterpark	Marcite repairs to the large hole in the zero depth. Several of the larger cracks in the bottom have been saw cut and repaired with marcite rapid set quartz. The long crack along the side of the overflow was saw cut and a urethane caulk used for this repair. A large section of loose plaster was removed and quartz marcite rapid repair material used for repair.
Amphitheater	Signage was supplied by communications for the Giving Tree and installed.
EMS Building	Experiencing problem with the carrier 3V control system on the HVAC. A-Air was called in to look at problems with the HVAC controls package. Tech changed several parameters on the program and could not find any glaring problems at this time.
Highlands Clubhouse	A crack in the secondary heat exchanger for the grill room furnace was discovered during fall pm services. Checked with Carrier and the part is still under warranty until 2027. Based on part availability the decision to replace the furnace or just the part will be made. Will need to do one other before heating season. Cracked heat exchangers have a high probability of leaking CO into the supply air

Turfgrass	Performed preventive maintenance on the boiler and heat pump for winter use. Chemical storage unit needs done.
Public Works	Two new pumps were installed for the in-floor heat at Public Works. Large circ pump rebuild is complete and Industrial Pump and Motor will return for us to install.
Haine Fire Station	Found power wire disconnected to restroom heater. Work order for electricians to see if there is enough power available to connect the wiring.
Municipal Building	 Bear Run preschool classroom conversion is complete. Expansion board for the silent panic system was installed and tested. A new emergency contact list was created and sent to monitoring for programming. The cubicles in the old communications office at the Municipal building were disassembled. Two stations were moved and setup in the old play center in Parks and Rec dept. along with cabinets. First Night decorations and assembly of the Christmas tree are beginning. Decorations will be handled by communications.
Fall Preventative Maintenance	Winter PM is completed on Graham park concessions, brine building, training center, Public works (pumps need returned). EMS, Turfgrass done, and Clubhouse completed. BCTP and Park Fire Station in progress.

GROUNDS
