Fairway Facts

- Clubhouse was weeded the last time the week of 11-1.
- Clubhouse house shrubbery was trimmed down for the winter months the week of 11-8.
- Clubhouse outside lighting was inspected and reset for the winter months.
- Apiary plants trimmed, weeds are sprayed and cleaned up the week of 11-1. This site is back on track.
- Fescue mowing is still ongoing.
- Fairways have been vented to alleviate compaction, release unwanted gases from the soil, help with drainage and create air flow to the root system. This was completed the week of 10-25.
- Potassium was applied to the greens the week of 11-1.
- All rough heads have been trimmed out for the season the week of 11-1
- All bunker noses have been mowed for the last time the week of 10-25.
- Pumphouse has been winterized the week of 11-1.
- Irrigation system was winterized the week of 11-8.
- Irrigation valves have been repaired on holes 9,5 and the driving range the week of 11-8.
- Leaf clean-up is ongoing and will continue throughout the month of November.
- Final mowing greens, tees and fairways was done the week of 11-8.
- Final mowing of all primary rough was done the week of 11-8.
- Jason has started the winter repair program.
- Snow mold sprays have been applied the week of 11-8. This is to protect greens, tees, and fairways from this winter fungus.
- Seasonal staff is starting to leave for the winter months, and everyone will be gone by November 30th.
