RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - XX

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP, A SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP OF THE COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING FORTH CERTAIN GUARANTEES IN RELATION TO AN APPLICATION FOR THE FY 2022-23 GREEN LIGHT-GO GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO ATTEST THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, Bureau of Maintenance and Operations, Transportation Operations Division, has provided grant funds through the Green Light-Go: Pennsylvania's Municipal Partnership Program designed to improve the efficiency and operation of existing traffic signals located in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Cranberry desires to install automatic activation of contingency plans at the Cranberry Township Traffic Operations Center (TOC) to improve communication/connections back to the TOC.

WHEREAS, the Township of Cranberry desires to submit an application to the FY 2022-23 Green Light-Go Program to fund the Contingency Plan Automation Project.

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the project is \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the 20% local share will be available for the purpose herein applied; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Cranberry's Capital Budget will contribute a 20% match totaling \$10,000 to partially fund the project; and apply for a grant application for \$40,000.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Cranberry agrees to comply with the requirements of the Green Light-Go Grant Program for the FY 2022-23 for the purpose of obtaining grant funds; and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same that the under-signed officials of the Township of Cranberry are authorized and directed to submit the Green Light-Go Application on behalf of Cranberry Township.
