A RESOLUTION OF CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP, A SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP OF THE COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND SIGN THE GRANT AGREEMENT FOR PENNSYLVANIA'S AUTOMATED RED LIGHT ENFORCEMENT (ARLE) FUNDING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS Cranberry Township continually seeks to make improvements to its Transportation network; and

WHEREAS The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation makes available grants-in-aid to such projects through the Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) Funding Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That Cranberry Township of Butler County hereby requested and was awarded an ARLE grant of \$300,000 from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to be used for traffic signal and related work at the intersection of Route 19 and Progress Avenue.

2. That the Applicant does hereby designate Dan Santoro, Township Manager, as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Cranberry Township and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to facilitate and assist in obtaining the awarded grant.
