



UTILITIES DEPARTMENT MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT FEBRUARY 2022

1/5/2022	-Plant staff backfilled RAS line bioreactor #3, paving will be completed in the spring.
1/11/2022	-Reinstalled old IPS pump #126 and returned it to normal duty.
1/12/2022	-Staff troubleshot ferric feed pump issue.
1/14/2022	-Completed oil changes and annual PM on all 4 bioreactor process blowers.
1/18/2022	-Installed a new control keypad on process blower #4 and returned to normal duty.
1/26/2022	-Troubleshot primary pump #3, both the suction and discharge lines packed full of sludge.
1/27/2022	-Plant staff assisted PW team by replacing a feed pump on the brine system.
1/31/2022	-Troubleshot the post ATAD tank level probe and new probe, controller was also installed.
1/31/2022	-Staff disassembled and inspected primary sludge grinder pump #1.
2/1/2022	-Installed a new automatic sampler at the IPS and relocated existing unit to headworks, old headworks unit is in storage as spare parts.
