## MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT

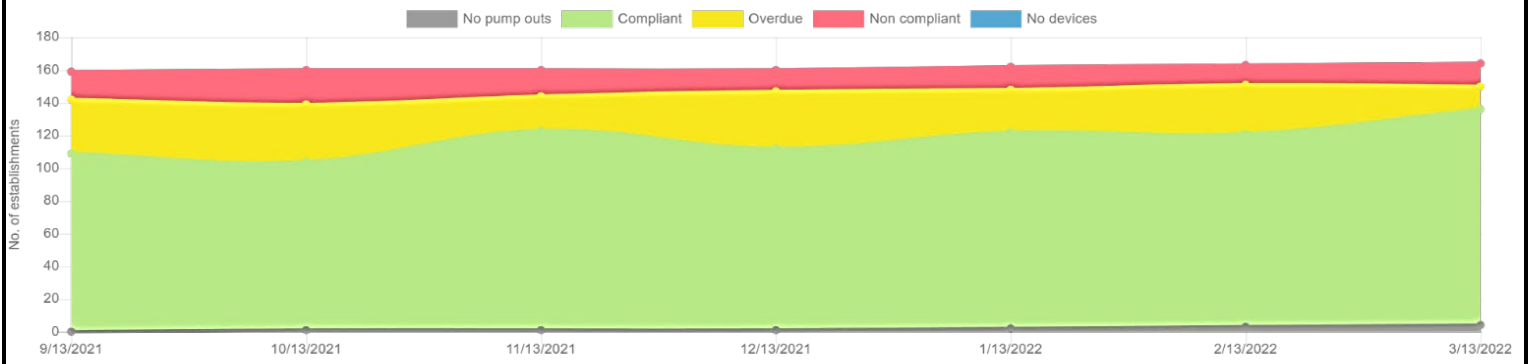
### MARCH 2022

#### BCTP

2/17/2022	-A high flow event prompted staff to operate the plant from 7:00a.m. Thursday through 3:30p.m. Friday (total rainfall 1.61in.).
2/22/2022	-Troubleshoot issue with <b>IPS</b> wet well air handler – replaced a broken belt.
2/25/2022	-A rainfall event prompted staff to man the plant from 4:30 a.m. Friday through 5:30p.m. (total rainfall 1.15in.).
3/02/2022	-Plant staff repaired broken fire hydrant in between <b>ATAD</b> reactors.
3/08/2022	-Operators replaced fan for Pennwood VFD #3.
3/09/2022	-Staff realigned process #3 blower pulleys and installed new belts.
Franklin Acres Pump Station	-No operational issues.
Briar Creek Pump Station	-No operational issues.
Wolfe Run Pump Station	-No operational issues.
Laurel Point Lift Station	-No operational issues.
Water Supply	-3/8-Operators troubleshoot leaking check valves at west tank, tightened packing on both valves.

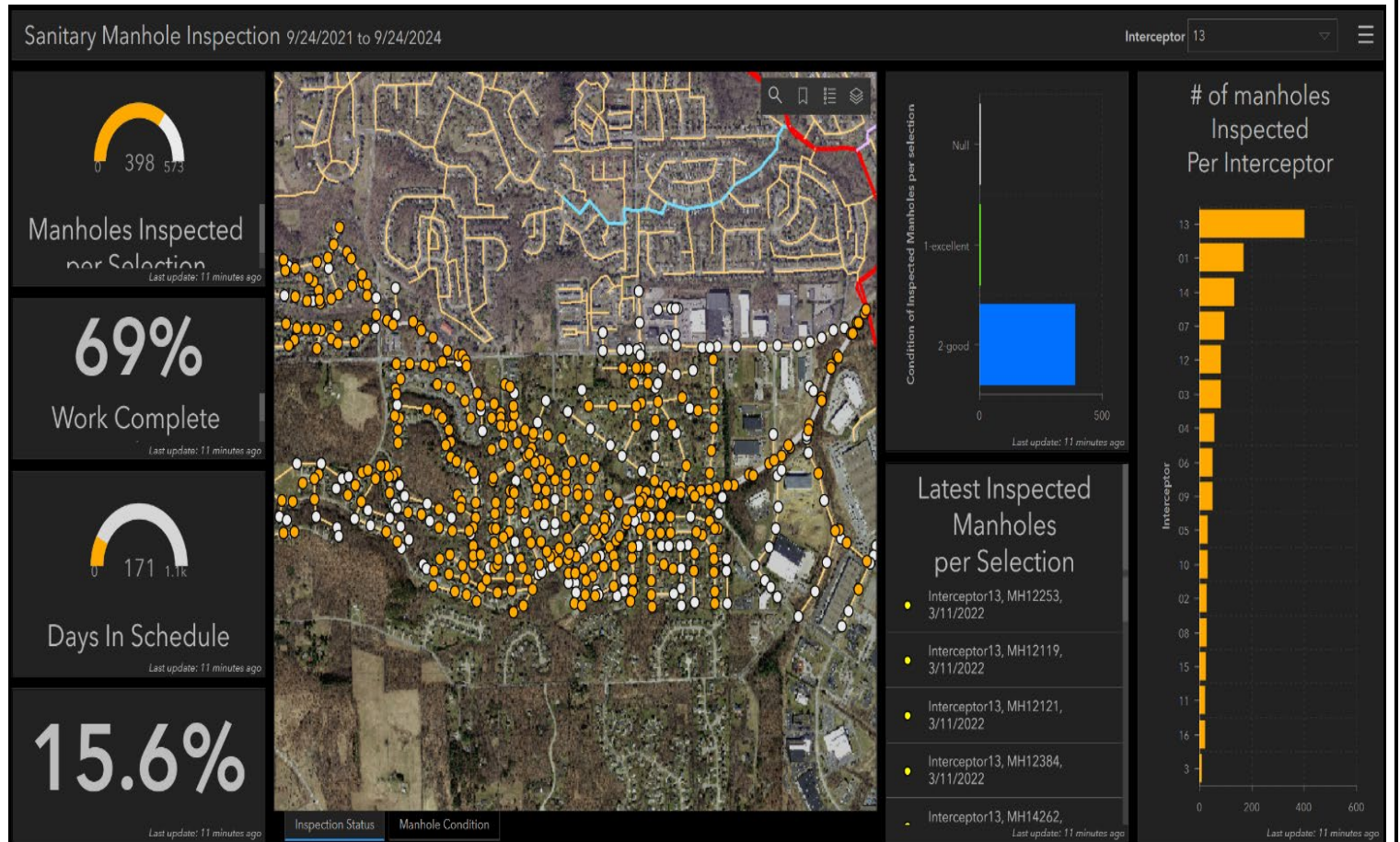

<b>Miscellaneous</b>	-No operational issues.

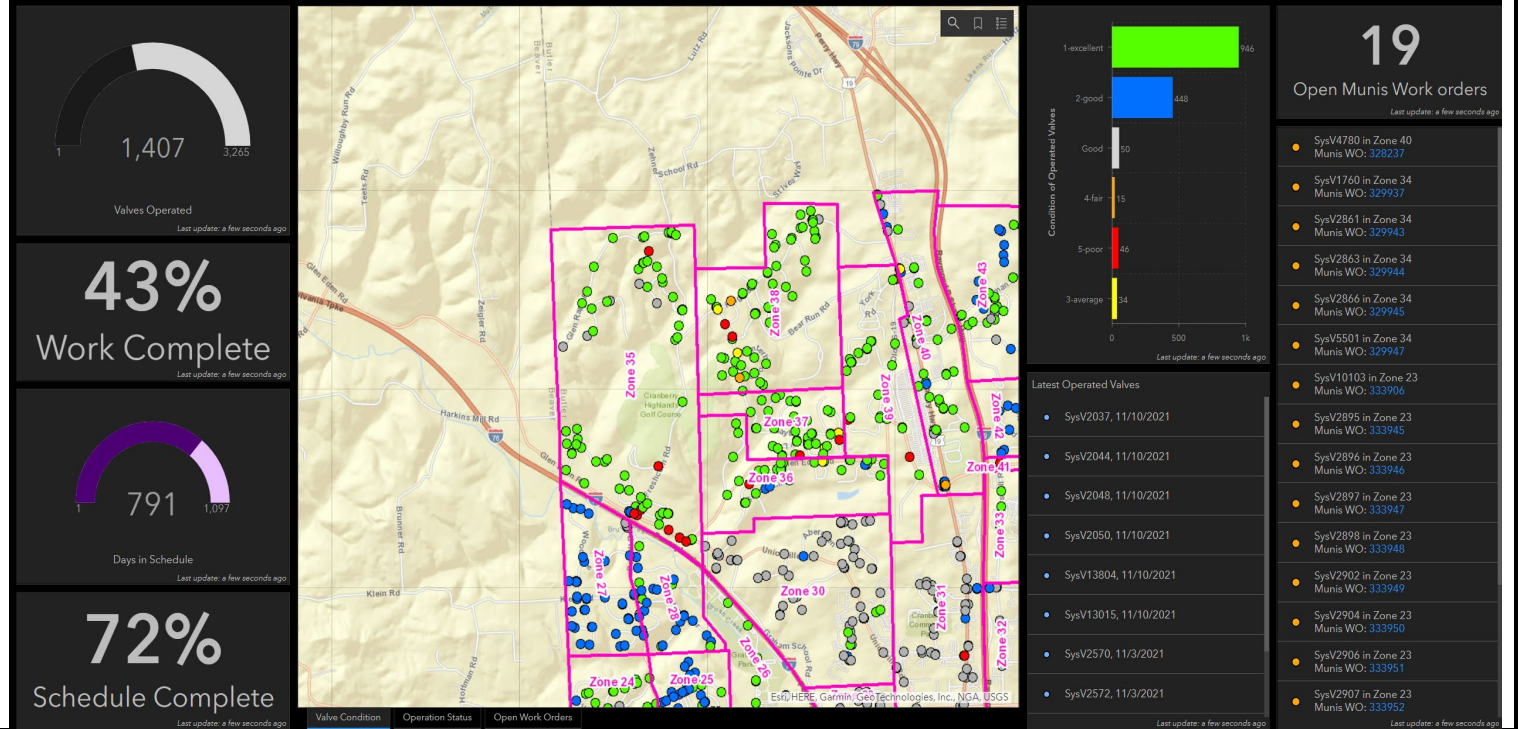
