RE: Purchase justification for the proposed **Police Body Worn Cameras** (CP-013)

After consultation with staff, I have reviewed the purchase noted above and recommend the Township Board of Supervisors consider authorizing the purchase of police body-worn cameras at the proposed initial cost of \$83,700.00. of which \$33,600 will be reimbursed via a grant once implemented.

This purchase is being recommended because of available grant funding to purchase proven technology that has benefitted many police departments throughout the country and the Commonwealth. The utilization of body-worn cameras and other video technologies should help keep our officers and members of the public safe and accountable.

If the Board of Supervisors approves, it would allow the Township to enter an agreement with Motorola Solutions, via a cooperative State contract.
