Fairway Facts

- Clubhouse was edged, weeded, and mulched the week of 5-23.
- Irrigation repairs done the week of 5-23 throughout the course.
- Flowers planted the week of 5-23 at the entrance sign and clubhouse front doors.
- Potassium was applied to the tees the week of 5-23. All bunker noses mowed the week of 5-23 and 6-20.
- Fairway flags trimmed the week of 5-23.
- Sprinklers trimmed the week of 5-23 and 6-13.
- Tee stones and PGA markers trimmed the week of 5-23 & 6-13.
- Tee divots are done weekly.
- Greens spiking program started the week of 6-1 and will continue throughout the golfing season. This to release unwanted gasses, allow water to move more freely into the soil profile and let the green breathe more freely.
- All course signs are cleaned as needed.
- Bunker edging began the week of 6-6 and was completed the week of 6-13.
- Hand watering started the week of 6-20. This is done around the greens, the greens, fairway spots that require more water than the sprinklers can put into a direct area.
- All perimeters' heads and couplers reset to water more precisely.
- Clubhouse, parking lot & staging area weeded the week of 6-20.
- Parking lot trees mulched around the week of 6-20.
- Area between tees 12 and 18 green was graded and seeded the week of 6-13.
- Green, fairway, approach, and tee mowers are being reground to ensure a good quality cut for the health of the turf. Jason started the week of 6-13 and will be done by the end of June 22, 2022
