FACILITIES	
Municipal Building	Work is continuing for the installation of the peace pole. A dedication ceremony is scheduled to be held on Wednesday 9/21/22.
EMS Building	A new rear entrance door has been ordered to replace the rusted existing door in place. The new door will be treated and coated with a tinted truck bed liner spray to prevent salt corrosion.
Highlands Clubhouse	The new internal time piece and controller for the range clock scheduled for replacement on 9/22/22. The relocations will allow for a surge protector and possibly a UPS to help protect the clock from any future electrical damage. Replacement of the downspouts on the pavilion were crushed and creating a backup during heavy rains.
Turfgrass	Preventive maintenance performed on the heat pump and exhaust fans.
Public Safety Building	Renovation work is in progress to repair damages from a major sewage backup in the first-floor men's restroom in the police department. The entire restroom was sprayed with a disinfectant / sanitizer to clean and prevent odors.

Public Works	Gutters and downspouts were installed on four of the entrance doors into the public works building, per safety review. Installation was done to prevent hazards from ice buildup during winter months.	
Community Park	Baseball concession ice machines and walk in freezers cleaned and shut down for the season.	
Graham Park	New steel doors and hardware have been ordered for the three concession restrooms. Expected delivery is early November.	
Haine Fire Station	Vinyl privacy fencing has been ordered for the new cement pad at the rear of the Haine Fire Station. The fence will be installed along the Haine School roadside to block the view of the pad and add to the security by keeping the equipment out of plain sight.	
Park Fire Station	Condenser fan motor was replaced in the HVAC unit providing for the basement and second floor.	
Fall Preventative Maintenance	Municipal building fall PM work on the roof top HVAC equipment is scheduled to begin the week of 9/26.	
Waterpark	Seasonal closing maintenance is under way. Heat pumps have been disconnected and drained, ice machine and conditioned make up air unit both cleaned and shut down for the winter.
