- Finally, after 3 years, have gotten rid of about 99.5% (only a few socks remain) of inherited "tired shop merchandise". Going forward this will allow us to produce better profit margins with new, sellable products. An example with golf shoes:
 - 2021 sales 212 pair -----2022 sales 119 pair Increased average sale price from \$54.70 to \$111.35 Increased gross sales from \$11,834 to \$13,620
 - With better profit margins from 21% to 36%
- To take advantage of our improved pro shop inventory situation, we are coordinating with Communication Department to design and utilize our much improved data base to send an email blast to drive a successful holiday season in the pro shop sales.
