FACILITIES	
Public Works	Garage door maintenance is scheduled for the mechanics bay week of 10/23/22. Soliciting quotes to replace both HVAC units for the first and second floors at public works.
Municipal Building	The mezzanine for the maintenance garage is scheduled for delivery on 10/24/22. The Liebert HVAC systems in the server room both failed causing a large heat load in the room jeopardizing the servers. Contractor found a bad compressor in the ceiling mounted unit and the floor unit was overheated to the point it was causing the compressor windings to appear there was a ground. Emergency replacement of the compressor was initiated, and the unit was back online within two days. A possible power outage was planned on 10/19 to raise an electrical vault for the rear lot construction. Questions on what did and did not have emergency backup power was raised. To clarify for future reference, a spreadsheet with all emergency power panel location including areas served is in progress. All emergency light fixtures, and wall plugs will be clearly marked.
Community Park	Baseball concessions ice machines and walk in freezers cleaned and shut down for the season.
