**A RESOLUTION BY CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP, A SECOND-
CLASS TOWNSHIP OF THE COUNTY OF BUTLER,
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING
APPLICATION TO THE COMMONWEALTH FINANCING
AUTHORITY MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION FUND
PROGRAM THROUGH THE PENNSYLVANIA
DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT (“DCED”) FOR THE ROUTE 19
MULTIMODAL SAFETY AND CONNECTIVITY
UPGRADES PROJECT.**

BE IT RESOLVED, that Cranberry Township of Butler County hereby requests a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant of \$1,277,198. from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the Route 19 Multimodal Safety and Connectivity Upgrades Project. The Project involves a series of vehicular, pedestrian, and bicycle improvements at the intersection of PA Route 19, and Brandt Drive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Applicant does hereby designate Daniel D. Santoro, Township Manager as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Cranberry Township and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
