A RESOLUTION OF CRANBERRY TOWNSHIP, A SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP OF THE COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO ACCEPT AND SIGN THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION FUND – AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP MANAGER TO ATTEST THE SAME.

WHEREAS Cranberry Township continually seeks to make improvements to its Transportation network; and

WHEREAS The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation makes available grants-in-aid to such projects through the Multimodal Transportation Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That Cranberry Township of Butler County hereby requests a Multimodal Transportation Fund grant of \$1,856,500 from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to be used for the Unionville Road and Progress Avenue Safety and Connectivity Upgrades Project.
2. That the Applicant does hereby designate Dan Santoro, Township Manager, as the official to execute all documents and agreements between Cranberry Township and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
