Ron Henshaw provided an overview of the Ridge at Pinebrook. Mr. Henshaw explained buffering to adjacent plans, trail connections and over ten acres of open space. There will be a stormwater pond, near the entrance, which will detain the water and release it at a slower rate than what is currently happening.

Grant Shiring, PVE, LLC, also explained the buffers, trail connections, open space, and stormwater runoff.

Supervisor Newpol asked if the entrance would be lighted.

Mr. Shiring explained the entrance will have two (2) lit pillars with a fence and sidewalk on the left side.

Public Comment:

William Thompson, 311 Ashbury Ct, expressed his satisfaction with the stormwater reduction. Mr. Thompson was concerned with the length of time to develop.

Eilen Battaglia, 8 Pinebrook Dr., has a traffic concern for the area. Ms. Battaglia is also concerned with the amount of development in Cranberry.

Gary Heusey, 405 Hidden Meadow Dr., was concerned about the swale maintenance. Staff will reach out to Mr. Heusey to discuss.
